

# Accelerated Reader Code of Conduct

## D. Harrison 5<sup>th</sup> Grade



The purpose of the Accelerated Reader program is to encourage reading and improve reading skills. With this in mind, students are expected to follow the rules described below:

1. Students may only take tests on books they have read.
2. Students may not take a test on a book which has been made into a movie unless they have read the book. On these books, students will only receive points for scores of 80% and above.
3. Students may not use Cliff notes, classic comic books, videos, or abridged versions of the book.
4. Students may not take tests for other students.
5. Students may not discuss AR questions or answers with other students. Strict test security must be observed.
6. Students must not reveal their password to anyone other than a parent or teacher.

### Consequences

Students who break the rules will face the following consequences:

1. The test or tests involved in the cheating incident will receive a score of 0.
2. The student will not be able to earn any rewards in the AR program for the remainder of the school year.
3. The student or students involved will be referred immediately to the office.
